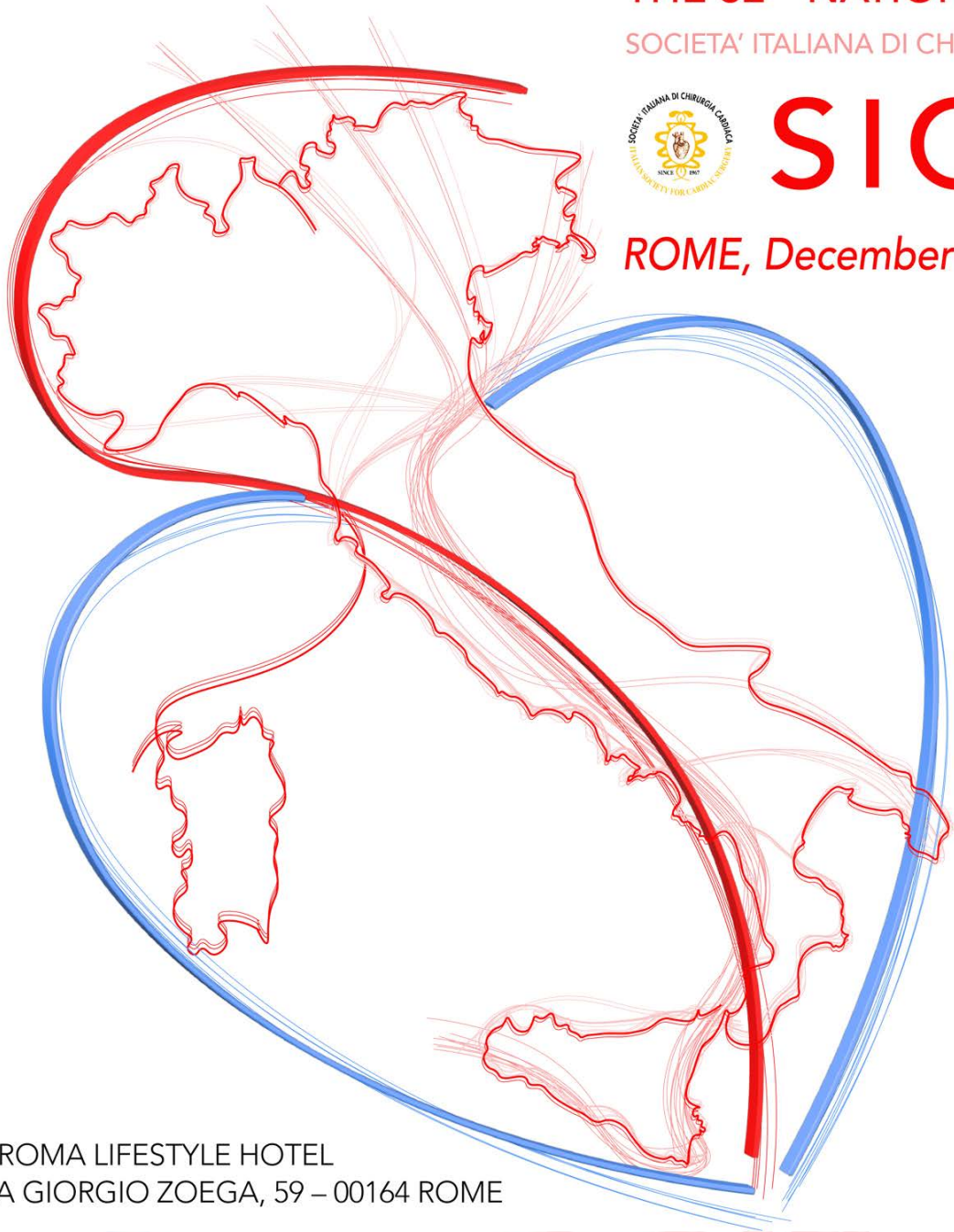

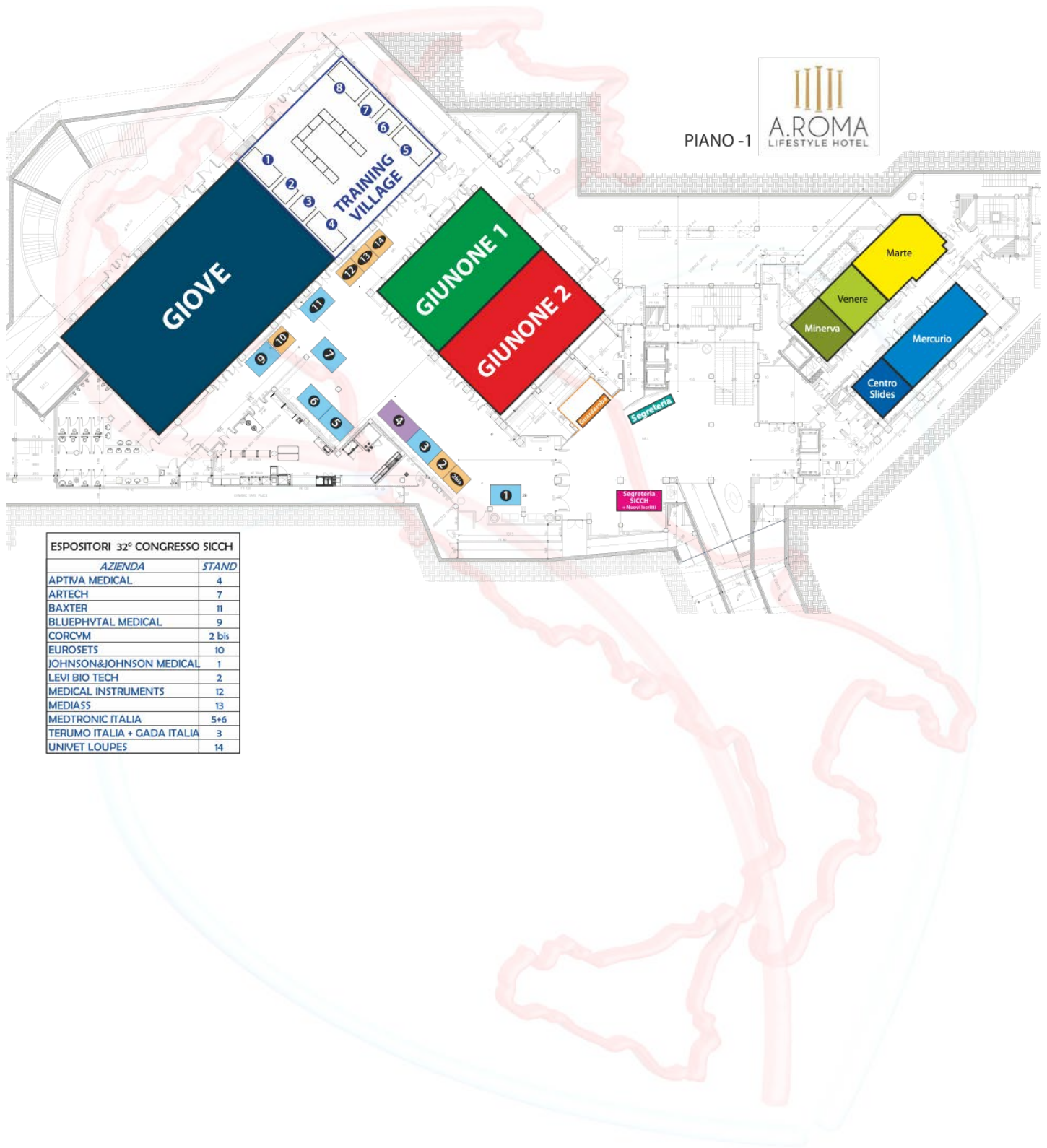

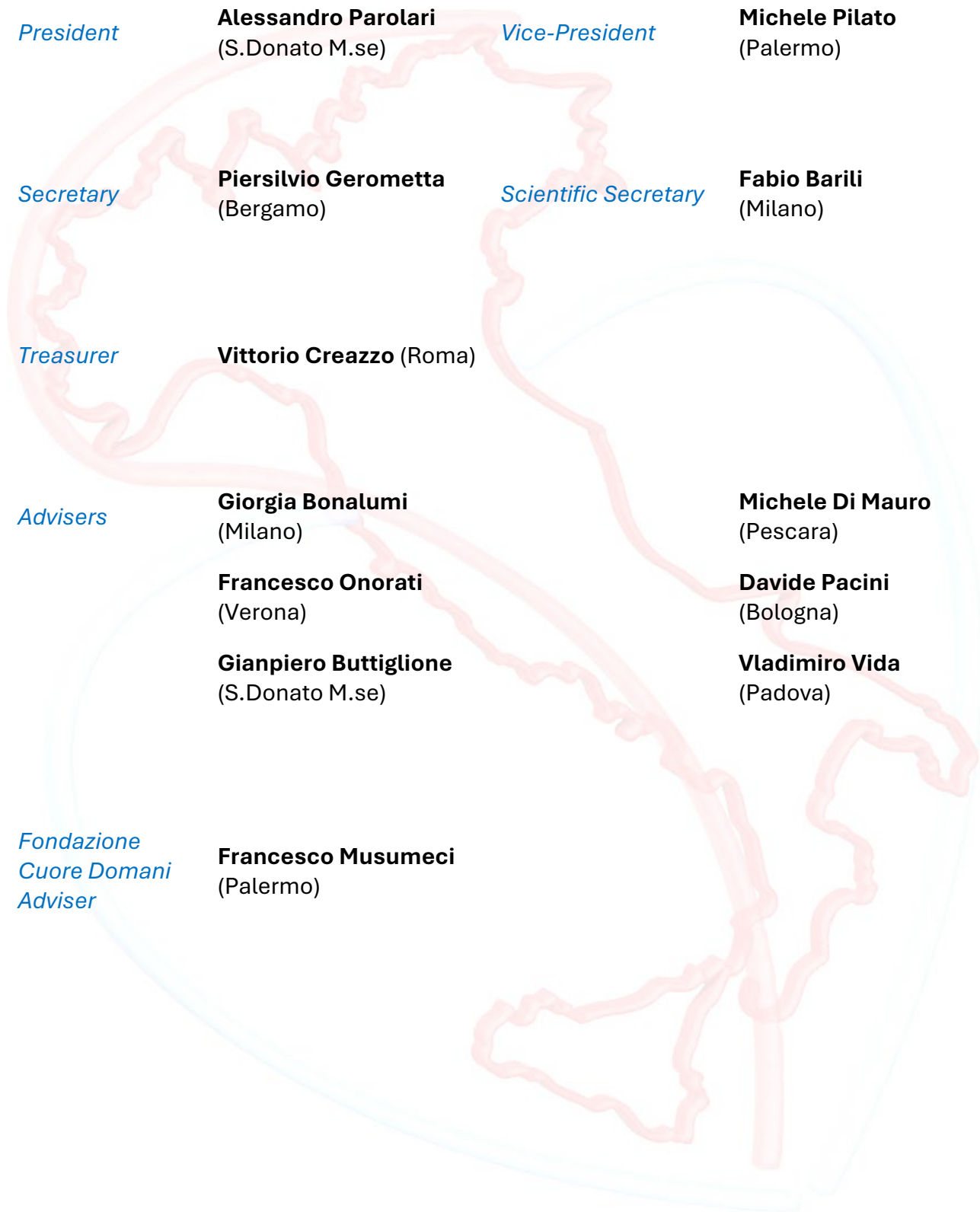


EXHIBITION FLOOR PLAN

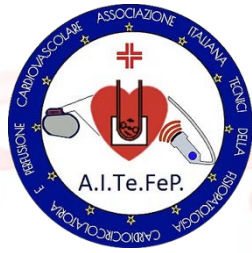
